Hospice Massage Therapist

As a member of the Hospice of Dubuque Interdisciplinary Team, the Hospice Massage Therapist must:

- be a graduate of a state-licensed massage therapy program and possess a license to practice in Iowa, and be able to apply for licensure in Wisconsin and Illinois, if requested,
- be able to effectively assess and respond to the needs of patients and families in a variety of settings and with varied lifestyles,
- develop rapport and communicate effectively with patients and their families, fellow team members, and members of other healthcare organizations,
- participate in the development of the Interdisciplinary Team's plan of care, and provide massage therapy services within that plan of care,
- be able to accurately document care provided,
- be able to load and unload equipment/supplies weighing up to 45 pounds, and maintain equipment/supplies specific to the massage therapy role,
- visit patients in their place of residence and provide care to patients in low beds,
- have a valid driver's license and acceptable driving record,
- have own reliable transportation, adequate car insurance, and be able to drive in all types of weather,
- meet regulatory requirements and applicable laws, and abide by Hospice of Dubuque's policies and procedures,
- meet and abide by Hospice of Dubuque's Standards of Conduct and Code of Ethics.

Hospice of Dubuque provides orientation, ongoing mentoring, and staff education so team members can continue to grow as professionals while doing work that truly makes a difference in the lives of those entrusted to our care. This is an hourly staff position with a comprehensive wage and benefit package. Travel time and mileage are reimbursable when making patient visits.
